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## **Senior Independence Receives Perfect ODH Survey**

**TOLEDO, OH** - Senior Independence Home Health has received a deficiency-free survey from the Ohio Department of Health. This is the fourth consecutive deficiency-free survey for Senior Independence Greater Toledo Region. The Ohio Department of Health surveys are conducted on-site and are unannounced. These surveys include an audit of many patient records as well as visits to patients' homes. A deficiency-free survey means that the agency has met and/or exceeded all of the standards set by the Ohio Department of Health.
